AGREEMENT

BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE HELLENIC REPUBLIC AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA ON COOPERATION IN THE FIELDS OF EDUCATION, CULTURE AND SCIENCE.

The Government of the Hellenic Republic and the Government of the Republic of Armenia, referred to from now and on as the Contracting Parties, led by their wish to further develop and strengthen the friendly relationship already existing between the two countries.

Wishing to develop their cooperation in the fields of education, science and technology, culture, mass media, athletism and youth.

Acting according to the Helsinki Final Act of the Conference on Security and Cooperation in Europe, the Conclusive Texts of the meetings in Madrid and Vienna, the provisions of the Paris Chart on New Europe, as well as the Final Text on CSCE's Symposium on cultural inheritage signed in 1991 in Krakow, have decided to conclude the present Agreement and have agreed upon the following:

Article 1

The Contracting Parties will take the necessary measures in order to contribute to the development of the cooperation in various sectors of education and science.

To this end they will:

Strengthen the cooperation between the Higher Educational Institutions and the Science Academies of the two countries.

Promote the teaching of the language and culture of the other country.

Exchange scientific personnel of the Higher Educational Institutions.

Contribute to the exchange of knowledge and experience in all educational levels.
