country provided that no passenger may be taken up or set down, unless, otherwise decided by the Joint Committee.

- «Occasional services» are:
- a. Closed door tours, that is to say services, whereby the same vehicle is used to carry the same group of passengers throughout the journey and to bring them back to the place of departure, which is the country where the vehicle is registered.
- b. Services which make the outward journey, laden and the return journey unladen.
- c. Services which make the outward journey unladen and the return journey laden.
- d. All other services which do not meet the above criteria.

B. Access to the market

Article 5

- 1. The occasional services referred to in Article 4, paragraph 5a and 5b, shall be exempted from the need for any transport authorisation on the territory of the Contracting Party, where the vehicle is not registered.
- 2. The occasional services shall be carried out under the cover of a control document.
- 3. The control document shall consist of a journey form.
- 4. The journey form shall contain at least the following information:
- a/ the type of service
- b/ the main itinerary
- c/ the carrier(s) involved
- d/ a complete list of passengers
- 5. The books of journey forms or journey forms shall be supplied by the competent authorities of the Contracting Party where the vehicle is registered or by bodies appointed by those authorities.
- 6. Occasional services referred to in Article 4, paragraphs 5c and 5d, can only be operated on the basis of adequate permits. The number of permits is to be determined by the responsible authorities in the countries that signed the Agreement on the occasion of the session of the Joint Committee, referred to in Article 14.
