- 4. «Transit» means the transport of passengers starting from the territory of the Contracting Party, where the vehicle is registered crossing the territory of the other country provided that no passenger may be taken up or set down.
- 5. «Occasional services» are:
 - a. Closed door-tours, that is, services, whereby the same vehicle is used to carry the same group of passengers throughout the journey and to bring them back to the place of departure, which is the country where the vehicle is registered.
 - b. Services which make the outward journey laden and the return journey unladen.
 - c. Services which make the outward journey unladen and the return journey laden.
 - d. All other services which do not meet the above criteria.

B. Access to the market

Article 5

The occasional services referred to in Article 4, paragraphs 5 a and 5 b, shall be exempted from the need for any transport authorisation on the territory of the Contracting Party, where the vehicle is not registered.

The occasional services shall be carried out under the cover of a control document.

The control document shall consist of a journey form.

The journey form shall contain at least the following information:

1. Type of service;
