

14. Vehicles performing technical aid or the repair of damaged vehicles (service and refit vehicles);
15. Transport of cargo to be used for education and advertising purposes;
16. The carriage of goods in motor vehicles, whose permissible laden weight, including that of trailers, does not exceed 6 tons or whose permissible payload, including that of trailers, does not exceed 3,5 tons;

With regard to the transport in the first paragraph of this Article, the driver must keep all papers and documents that clearly indicate that one of the above kinds of transport is the case.

III. GENERAL PROVISIONS

Article 14

In order to regulate all questions regarding the implementation and application of this Agreement, a Joint Committee shall be established.

This Committee is to be composed of the representatives of the competent authorities of the two Contracting Parties who can invite representatives of the road transport operators to the meetings.

The Joint Committee shall meet once per year or at the request of either Contracting Party, alternately in either Contracting Party. The Agenda of the meeting shall be presented by the Contracting Party hosting, or requesting, if this is the case, the meeting, at least two weeks in advance. Each meeting shall be concluded with the adoption of a Protocol signed by the heads of delegations of the two Contracting Parties.

The Joint Committee shall also decide upon the time limit, as well as the way of exchanging data and all other relevant information.
